Chancellor's Regulation No. 10./2021 of . C. December 2021

on introducing "Safety regulations in WUT dormitories during the COVID-19 epidemic"

Under § 6 of WUT Rector's Regulation No. 110/2021 of 18 November 2021 on functioning of the Warsaw University of Technology during the Covid-19 epidemic as of 19 November 2021, it is resolved as follows:

§ 1

The procedure "Safety regulations in WUT dormitories during the COVID-19 epidemic" shall be introduced, constituting an Appendix hereto.

§ 2

The WUT Chancellor's Regulation No. 7/2021 of 28 May 2021 on introducing the procedure "Safety regulations in WUT dormitories during COVID-19 epidemic threat" shall expire.

§ 3

The Regulation enters into force upon signing.

SAFETY REGULATIONS IN WUT DORMITORIES DURING THE COVID-19 EPIDEMIC

General

- 1. All persons staying in student dormitories, hereinafter referred to as "SD", shall read and follow the procedure "Safety regulations in WUT dormitories during the COVID-19 epidemic".
- 2. Principles regarding the proper use of the premises during the epidemic are displayed on notices placed in SD.
- 3. All persons entering SD shall duly disinfect their hands. Bottle dispensers with disinfectants are available near the entrance to the building.

Using communal areas

- 4. In compliance with the regulations arising from relevant Rector's regulations, as well as the current legal regulations and safety rules, a limited number of social gatherings in SDs are allowed (social, integration, family, educational, etc.). The number of people allowed to attend such gatherings shall be specified by the SD Manager upon consultation with the Council of Residents.
- 5. Visitors to SD are allowed from 8 a.m. to 10 p.m., in compliance with the provisions of the Rules and Regulations for Visitors.
- 6. Sleepovers and staying after 10 p.m. are allowed in compliance with the provisions of the SD Rules and Regulations.
- 7. Every visit to an SD shall be entered in the check-in/check-out register.
- 8. The invited visitors shall be collected personally by a resident from the reception area and shown to the door after the visit is over. The resident inviting a visitor shall be responsible for their stay and following the effective procedures.
- 9. In the event of any of the residents or the Council of Residents objecting to a visit, the visitor shall not be allowed to visit the SD.
- 10. Before entering an SD, all visitors must have their body temperature measured. If the temperature is higher than 37°C, the visitor may not enter the SD.
- 11. Rules of social distancing shall be followed. When using communal areas, a safe distance must be kept of at least 1.5 metres and a mask must be worn covering one's mouth and nose.
- 12. Communal spaces such as quiet study rooms, luggage storeroom, TV rooms, snooker, and table-tennis rooms may be used provided that sanitary restrictions which are currently in effect in the Republic of Poland are followed. Ballrooms may only be used as meeting rooms. The final decision regarding communal spaces shall be taken by the Manager of the Student Dormitory upon consultation with the Council of Residents.
- 13. SD residents shall purchase personal protective equipment on their own.

Employees

- 14. To limit direct contact with employees, electronic communication, email, and phone use are the preferred forms of communication.
- 15. SD employees shall limit meetings and internal sessions to an absolute minimum.
- 16. Every effort shall be made to keep the workstations clean and hygienic.

Administrative issues

17. If possible, administrative issues should be performed remotely with the SD administration via phone, email, etc. If it is impossible, personal contact shall be arranged with the SD Administration by phone.

Rules of conduct in the event of infection

- 18. If any disturbing symptoms implying a SARS-CoV-2 infection occur, immediately contact your GP or any other appropriate entity following the current regulations regarding that matter. Instructions and orders shall be strictly followed.
- 19. Any resident who is required to self-quarantine in connection with Covid-19 shall immediately notify the SD Manager on the quarantine length. The SD Manager shall coordinate further actions, and shall transfer information by email to powiadomienia@pw.edu.pl and inform the Chairperson of the Council of Residents about any quarantined persons in the Student Dormitory.
- 20. Governmental guidelines and recommendations for the SARS-CoV-2 epidemic issued by the Chief Sanitary Inspectorate and other entities shall be followed in any case.

Other regulations

21. To all matters not regulated herein, provisions of WUT Rector's Regulation No. 110/2021 of 18 November 2021 on functioning of WUT during the COVID-19 epidemic as of 19 November 2021 shall apply.
