**on introducing the Regulations for using recreation rooms in student dormitories at the  
Warsaw University of Technology**

Under § 24 section 11 item 5 pursuant to section 9 item 6 and section 7 of the Organisational Regulations of the Warsaw University of Technology, constituting an Appendix to Regulation No. 92/2019 of the WUT Rector of 4 December 2019 on introducing Organisational Regulations of the Warsaw University of Technology it is resolved as follows:

§ 1

Regulations for using recreation rooms in WUT student dormitories shall be introduced, which are an Appendix to this Regulation.

§ 2

The Regulation enters into force upon signing.

REGULATIONS FOR USING RECREATION ROOMS IN STUDENT DORMITORIES AT  
THE WARSAW UNIVERSITY OF TECHNOLOGY

1. Regulations for using recreation rooms in student dormitories at the Warsaw University of Technology, hereinafter referred to as 'Regulations', shall specify the rules of the correct use of recreation rooms in student dormitories at the Warsaw University of Technology.
2. General laws shall also apply to the use of rooms mentioned in section 1, particularly regulations for conduct during the pandemic.
3. Commencing exercise shall be equivalent to accepting these Regulations.
4. Entering a recreation room shall be possible by opening the door with a smart card or key received from the reception after presenting an ID and verification by checking against the list of persons authorised to use the recreation room, hereinafter referred to as 'the List', whose template is Appendix No. 1 to these Regulations.
5. Only persons from the List shall do exercise in the recreation room, subject to item 6.
6. If justified, after obtaining written consent from the room supervisor, a visitor to the SD may be brought to the recreation room by the user.
7. Each person staying in the recreation room shall present their ID to verify their identity by checking it against the List or present the consent specified in section 6 upon the request of the reception, member of the Council of Residents, or Disciplinary Committee.
8. In rooms with heavy equipment, the minimum number of exercising users shall be 2.
9. Users must not wear any coats or non-sports footwear in the recreation room.
10. Persons using recreation rooms shall do exercise in sports attire and clean, closed footwear.
11. To keep the equipment in a hygienic state, towels shall be used.
12. Sports equipment shall be used by persons who have no health contraindications for doing sports requiring strength.
13. Persons using recreation rooms shall sign a declaration which is Appendix No. 2 to these Regulations, in which they confirm that their health allows them to play sports and do recreational activities.
14. Information on personal data processing for persons using recreation rooms is Appendix No. 3 to these Regulations.
15. Persons under the influence of alcohol, intoxicants, etc. must not use recreation rooms.
16. It is prohibited to use damaged equipment or equipment that is out-of-order. All damage shall be immediately reported to the room supervisor.
17. Exercise shall be done with due care for the equipment in recreation rooms.
18. Persons causing any damage to the equipment shall bear financial responsibility for the damage.
19. Each case of damaged equipment or inappropriate behaviour shall be reported to the recreation room supervisor.
20. On completing the training session, the equipment shall be returned to its place.
21. Disciplinary measures specified in item 25 shall be taken against any theft and deliberate damage to the equipment or the room.
22. Persons using recreation rooms shall follow the recommendations of the instructor or room supervisor. The administration, SD manager, and recreation room supervisor shall bear no responsibility for any exercise injuries.
23. The administration, SD manager, and recreation room supervisor shall bear no responsibility for any valuable items left in the room.
24. All notices displayed in recreation rooms or issued by the supervisor shall have the same validity as these Regulations.

25. Breach of these Regulations may lead to removing a person from a recreation room, losing the right to use recreation rooms, limiting access to rooms and Internet in the SD, and if justified, may render a person liable to prosecution or disciplinary action.
26. Any contentious issues not specified herein shall be resolved by the SD manager in agreement with the recreation room supervisor.

## INFORMATION CLAUSE ON PERSONAL DATA PROCESSING FOR PERSONS USING RECREATION ROOMS

Pursuant to Art. 13 of the Regulation 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons regarding the processing of personal data and to the free flow of the data and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (Journal of Laws EU L 119/1 of 4 May 2016), hereinafter referred to as GDPR, the Warsaw University of Technology hereby informs that:

1. The administrator of your personal data is the Warsaw University of Technology, with the official seat at pl. Politechniki 1, 00-661 Warsaw.
2. The administrator has appointed the Data Protection Inspector (DPI) to supervise the processing of personal data. The Inspector can be contacted at the email address: [iod@pw.edu.pl](mailto:iod@pw.edu.pl).
3. The administrator shall process your personal data to the following extent: name, surname.
4. Your personal data shall be processed by the administrator to provide access to a recreation room – the legal basis of the processing of your personal data is Art. 6 section 1 letter f of GDPR.
5. The Warsaw University of Technology has no intention of forwarding your data beyond the European Economic Area.
6. You are entitled to access your personal data and you have the right to correct the data, the right to demand to delete them, limit the processing of the data, the right to object to the processing of the data. Since the processing of your data is not based on your consent, you are not entitled to transfer the data.
7. Your personal data shall not be made available to third parties (administrators) except for entities authorised following legal regulations.
8. Access to your personal data may be granted to entities (processing entities) that may be given tasks related to the processing of personal data by the Warsaw University of Technology.
9. You shall not be subjected to automated decision-making, including your profiling, by the Warsaw University of Technology.
10. Providing your personal data is not obligatory; however, unless you provide your personal data, you will not be able to access the recreation room.
11. Your personal data shall be processed during the academic year and summer holiday and for the period necessary to secure possible claims.
12. You are entitled to make a complaint to the supervisory authority - President of the Office for Personal Data Protection if you find that the processing of your personal data violates the provisions of the GDPR Regulation.
